

College Financial Aid Committee

Membership: Two affirmed persons

Term: Three (3) year term

Selection Process: By discernment and affirmation process conducted by the Leadership Commission

Function/Objective: To provide financial assistance to students attending specific Anabaptist church-related colleges and universities.

Responsibilities:

- To determine the number and names of persons in the congregation attending specific church-related colleges and universities each term.
- To provide request applications to students for financial aid.
- To determine the amount of aid given per student on a per-term basis.
- To supply college or university with a list of students receiving financial aid.
- To properly distribute aid to the participating colleges and universities.
- To annually determine the destination of any excess funds raised for a particular group of students.
- To properly allocate and authorize the distribution of excess funds.
- To update families of students and church as a whole of needed balances.

Accountability: To students, contributors, participating colleges/universities, Church Council, Congregation.

Annual Report: Strongly recommended for historical purposes.
