**REGULATIONS FOR USE OF THE
MARTINS MENNONITE CHURCH (MMC) FACILITIES
Revisions approved by Church Council 8/3/10**

1. Any group using any MMC facilities shall leave all chairs, tables, and other equipment as they found them unless otherwise specified by the janitor.
2. MMC households shall have free use of facilities for weddings, funerals, reunions, or similar events unless janitorial services are needed. Sign up on the calendar located in the kitchen.
3. All reservations for use of facilities are to be made with the pastor(s). Priority will be given to church members (in case of conflict). For non-attendees to reserve the building more than 60 days in advance of the event requires the approval of MMC Council.
4. Any group using facilities and leaving without cleaning shall pay the church janitor a fee of \$15.00 per man-hour of cleaning time required. After 9:00 p.m. the hourly wage is \$24.00 per hour. If food is eaten in the Fellowship Hall and kitchen, it is to be swept and wet mopped.
5. Chestnut Ridge has free use of facilities for funerals unless clean-up time is required. The church involved will provide its own parking attendants, ushers, cooks, etc.
6. The following are the suggested minimum donations for non-attendees who use the facilities for weddings, funerals, reunions or similar events:

For the Courtyard (i.e. wedding) or Sanctuary	\$100.00
Fellowship Hall and Kitchen	\$150.00
Every hour over 6 hours	\$10.00/hour
PA Operator	\$15.00/hour
(PA Operator may be the Church Monitor)	

7. The chairs, tables, and other equipment may be borrowed by church families and other church groups (the small child plastic chairs for the Day Care are not to be borrowed). Please clear with the pastor(s) for possible conflict with church activities. All chairs and tables are to be returned for Sunday services. Persons who borrow items must sign their name on the sheet provided (on the cupboard door in the storage closet) and return them as indicated. Please check with the Hospitality Committee for permission to borrow any kitchen items (a sign-out sheet is in the kitchen). Borrowing the wheel chair or walkers for usage outside of MMC is to be cleared with the pastor(s).
8. When a specific portion of the MMC facilities is requested, the group is asked to limit its usage to the area being rented. When non-attendees use any facilities, an MMC attendee is to monitor the event at \$15.00 per hour.
9. Please keep food or drink in the Fellowship Hall, in order to avoid soiling the carpet. If food is served and the floors are not swept and wet mopped, the janitor is to be paid for clean-up. (See #4 above)
10. Following each event, all garbage containers are to be emptied with plastic bags tied securely and placed in the corral on the southwest side of the main building.
11. The church will not grant permission to social clubs, civic groups, scouts, or other non-church-related groups to use any facilities on a regular basis. There is to be no smoking on the premises. No bingo games or other games of chance are allowed.

Fees are subject to adjustment depending on the situation and will be determined by the Church Trustees.

PAVILION-YOUTH ROOM USAGE GUIDELINES

1. The MYF has priority.
2. Reservations must be approved by the Pastor.
3. The suggested minimum donation for use of the pavilion, restroom, and youth room by non-attendees of MMC is: \$65 AND pay \$15 per hour for MMC monitor.
4. All groups using the facilities are expected to follow the **cleaning checklist posted above the drinking fountain** prior to leaving. Any extra cleaning will be done by the youth at \$15/man-hour (for the MYF account), or by the janitor at the same rate.

BASIC UNDERSTANDINGS

1. Because the church has other activities such as Day Care, MYF, etc., refrigerators and freezers will not be emptied for outside use.
2. The maximum capacity for the Fellowship Hall is 200 if food is served. Non-attendees of MMC are not to exceed that number. (Exception: funerals)
3. Parents are expected to monitor their children's activities at all times while using any MMC facilities.

BORROWING TABLES AND CHAIRS

1. Please check the sign out sheet on the brown cupboard in the closet and the calendar in the kitchen to see if someone has signed up for building use or has already reserved tables and/or chairs. If either building is reserved, contact that person to see if all the tables/chairs will be in use.
2. The round tables may be borrowed by MMC attendees. They are not to be rolled.
3. Only the yellow and green chairs may be taken off-site and/or used outside.

DESIGNATED STORAGE AREAS

Recommended use of storage areas within the church building:

NW Balcony: audio, heilesgeschichte items, and MYF items

NE Balcony: props

Main Floor NW: fan controls

Main Floor NE: ushers, decorations

NW Stairway: Sunday School

NW Basement: Trustees

SW Old Furnace Room: Sunday School, historical, Day Care

Closet above pulpit: Day Care

**West coat rack: wheelchair and walkers

**NW S.S. room: decorations, material, wreaths

PROCEDURES FOR CANCELING SUNDAY SERVICES

The following persons should be involved in the process: Pastor, the Trustees, and the Janitor. Any scheduled guest speaker/group etc. needs to be given the name and phone number of a contact person from MMC if last minute changes would occur for the guest(s). Then the Elders and Worship Leader need to be contacted to plan an alternative. When the conditions are such that the Pastor, Trustees and Janitor determine services should be canceled, then the Elders and Worship Leader are to be notified next. Notification of the congregation will be accomplished on the radio (WQKT/WKVX,WCRF) and television (FOX 8) contacted by the Head Trustee and/or through the Pastor(s)/Elder Team by phone.
